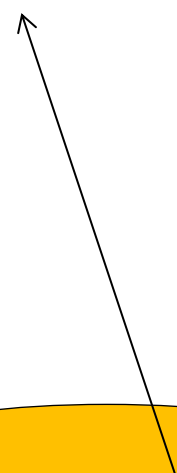

NO Nuts reminder

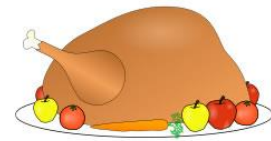
Please can we remind you not to send in any cakes / biscuits that contain nuts for the cake sale on Friday 23rd November as some children / adults in school may have severe nut allergies.
