### Lockdown Procedures

These are designed so that adults and pupils know what to do if there is an incident in the school grounds and so everyone can keep safe within the secure school building. We will practise our lockdown procedures this week. It is a shame we have to do this but it is a necessary requirement.

Our procedures state that we will blow a whistle and call out "We are locking up". Children will be kept inside the classrooms and any children outside will come in.

We endeavour to keep the stress to a minimum for the children. During our worship there will be a full explanation for the children of what will be happening before the practise.

We are making you aware so that you are prepared should your child come home and tell you about it. We find a useful way of explaining this to the children is to compare it to fire drills, which we have regularly in school - if the fire is inside, we evacuate - if the fire was outside, we all need to keep safe inside the school. If you have any queries, please do come in and see us.
