Dear Parents

It has been a busy term, with the children enjoying their topics, 'Pirates & Explorers' and 'Hero's & Superhero's'.

The KS1 visit to the Historic Dockyard was a great success. The children thoroughly enjoyed the Pirate Shipmate workshop and behaved beautifully throughout the day.

The Early Years children were introduced to PC Pack, our local School Police Liaison officer. During her visit she showed them her uniform and talked about keeping safe. We also had a visit from our local Firefighters along with a very shiny red fire engine! The children were able to climb on the fire engine and squirt the hose pipe! They then enjoyed using the outside area as fire and police stations - we have had some excellent talking and writing from all the children about these experiences.

Watches, jewellery and earrings

Please do not allow your child to wear any form of wrist watch into school. Whilst we appreciate the importance of our children learning to tell the time, we cannot guarantee that any personal wristwatches would not be damaged or lost. We have specific school watches that are used during lesson time to encourage and help our children tell the time.

Ear rings: West Sussex County Council regulations state that no jewellery of any kind is allowed to be worn in P.E. This includes ear-rings. Children must remove any ear-rings worn themselves and take responsibility for them. If your child wears ear-rings to school, in the interests of safety, please make sure that only plain studs are worn. Please could you either teach them how to remove them for PE and keep them safe or please provide some tape, such as 3M tape, to be kept in the PE bag so your child can put a little over each ear stud.

Big Little Sing for Year Two


